

CONFERENCE PRESENTATION

The first Bicocca Hepato-Gastro Meeting has been planned aiming at presenting the highest profiles in the main topics in **Hepatology** and **Gastroenterology**.

The Meeting is jointly organized by the University of Milano-Bicocca, Papa Giovanni XXIII Hospital of Bergamo, Milan Niguarda Hospital and S.Gerardo Hospital of Monza. The meeting is structured in plenary sessions based on **state-of-the-art lectures** and **interactive or live sessions workshops**.

Hepatology (topics covered: immunology and pathogenesis of hepatitis B infection, gut vascular barrier and liver diseases, autoimmune diseases, genetic therapies in autoimmune liver diseases, new definition of decompensated cirrhosis, artificial intelligence in risk stratification in non alcoholic fatty liver disease (NAFLD), genetics in NAFLD, hemocromatosis, polycystic liver disease, non-invasive assessment of hepatic fibrosis and portal hypertension, microbiota in liver diseases).

Onco-Hepatology (topics covered: organoids and animal models for the study of liver tumors, lipid metabolism and cancer immunotherapy, biomarkers for cholangiocarcinoma, therapeutic approach to hepatocellular carcinoma, basics of cholangiocarcinoma, molecular landscape and therapeutic strategies in cholangiocarcinoma, molecular basis for personalized therapy in GEP-NET).

Liver transplantation (topics covered: HBV prophylaxis in LT: time for a change, ACLF and Liver Transplantation, gene therapy and liver transplantation for inborn errors of metabolism, role of histology in LT, novel therapies for pre and post-LT, coronary artery disease and LT).

Gastroenterology (topics covered: microbiota in gastrointestinal disorders, novel treatment strategies in inflammatory bowel diseases, irritable bowel disease, artificial intelligence in GI endoscopy, EUS/ERCP in biliopancreatic endotherapy, celiac disease, disease and diet interactions with virome, precision nutrition in IBD, updates on chronic pancreatitis, new treatments of short bowel syndrome, treatment of microscopic colitis).

Onco-Gastroenterology (topics covered: pancreatic cystic lesions: diagnostic and prognostic factors, Endoluminal therapy in cholangiocarcinoma, EUS ablative treatment of pancreatic tumors, Endotherapy of T1 rectal cancer, full thickness resections and suturing devices, screening in colorectal cancer).

The structure of the meeting is completed with **live endoscopy and surgery sessions** and short selected presentations from submitted abstracts.

The **University of Milano-Bicocca** is a public university which was established in Milan in 1998. The university is situated across two campuses comprising 25 modern buildings split between the city campus in Bicocca and the biomedical campus in Monza, a town close to Milan, for a total of 290,000m².

The University of Milano-Bicocca is a multi-discipline university training the professionals of tomorrow in a number of different fields: economics/statistics, law, science, medicine, sociology, psychology and pedagogy.

The university's educational offering is split into 70 study courses (36 Bachelor's Degrees and single-cycle Master's Degrees and 34 Master's Degrees) across seven disciplines: economics/statistics, law, medicine, psychology, sociology, science and education. 
